


So, what is an amphibian?

Do you know?

An animal is an amphibian if...

- it has a backbone (it is a vertebrate) and has no feathers, fur, hair, scales, or claws.



In addition, all amphibians...

- are cold-blooded. That means they cannot make their own body heat. Their bodies are the same temperature as their surroundings.



And most amphibians...

- live underwater and breathe with gills while young and live on land and breathe with lungs as adults;
- are born from eggs;
- have smooth skin.
