Cut out the cat images on page two and give one to each student. Have the students color their cats and glue them to a Popsicle stick. Have each student write a story about a journey his or her cat could take around the classroom, using as many prepositions as possible. (e.g. My cat jumped OVER Ashley, crawled UNDER Sam's desk, ran THROUGH the aisle, and ended up back AT my desk.) Ask for volunteers to act out their stories and have the class count the number of prepositions in each journey.
